When international art collectors Carlos and Rosa de la Cruz collaborated with American Custom Yachts to build their new dream machine, the result was destined to become a masterpiece.

Outfitted to meet the de la Cruzes' specific fishing, traveling, and comfort needs, the ACY72 *Yellowbird* features a clean, ultra-modern interior with four staterooms and four heads, along with an expansive saloon and a generous galley. A fully integrated electronics and entertainment package was provided by ACY affiliate IMS American.

Above-deck amenities include a massive center-console bridge with two full-size freezers, an automatically retracting bow pulpit, and a satin-finish tower crafted by Bausch-American Towers. Below decks, a spacious engine room houses a pair of 2,000-hp MTU 16V 2000s.

"We always believed that the custom wooden boats we build are truly works of fine art," says ACY president Dominick LaCombe. "It was confirmed when we were selected to build a vessel for one of the world's top art collectors."
